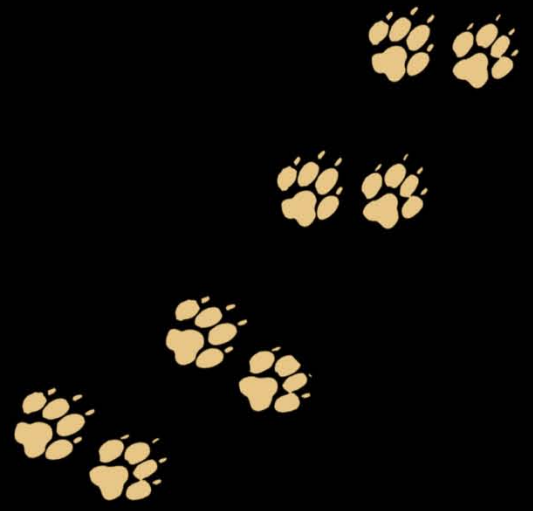

**mega + fauna = big + animals**

Over 46,000 years ago Megafauna inhabited part of the South-West region of Western Australia including the awe inspiring Mammoth Cave, located near Margaret River. Mammoth Cave was a unique time capsule preserving over 10,000 fossils, making it one of the largest and most important paleontological sites in Australia. The evidence discovered at this dig site unveiled new species previously unknown to science, allowing scientists to further unravel the evolutionary history of our unique Australian fauna.

This is why the Augusta Margaret River Tourism Association is proud to offer Megafauna Tours, so students can learn about these fascinating yet relatively unknown animals from the past.

The experience begins with an interactive presentation at the CaveWorks Eco Centre, located at Lake Cave, where participants will hear about the history of Megafauna in the region including their evolution, feeding habits, discovery and the importance of their existence to our world today.

The group is then guided through a private exploration of the magnificent Mammoth Cave, "our living museum". Participants will have the opportunity to see a 50,000 year old jawbone of one of these Megafauna species, and hear about the paleontological digs that took place in the cave.

**When:** Every day of the year, except Christmas!

**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours, including cave tour.
